Charfield has sustainable access to some key services and facilities, but lacks walking and cycling access to others.

A dedicated community centre, a post office and three public houses provide a range of community facilities within 800m of the settlement. The post office has recently been relocated to Avon Road, now operating from Steve's Shop; this is one of two convenience stores within a 1200m walking and cycling distance, there is also one comparison retail store, a hair dressers. Charfield contains one small safeguarded employment area. A major employer Renshaw PLC is also located within 2000m of the settlement however, Renishaw is not considered as a key service accessible by walking or cycling, due to a lack of any dedicated walk way or cycling facilities along the B4058. One primary school can be accessed by walking and cycling within the catchment, but there are no safely accessible secondary school within 3 miles. There is also superfast broadband access in parts of the settlement.

Charfield does not have walking or cycling access to any health facilities, a permanent library, range of comparison stores or larger scale food buying opportunities such as a supermarket. Additionally, Charfield lacks access to any major employers, which limits employment opportunities.

To assist sustainable access to certain key facilities and services, public transport connects Charfield to larger town centres of Yate, Thornbury and Wotton under Edge. These settlements contain the key services and facilities lacking in Charfield.

HEALTH AND COMMUNITY (800M), RETAIL (1200M) AND EMPLOYMENT (2000M)

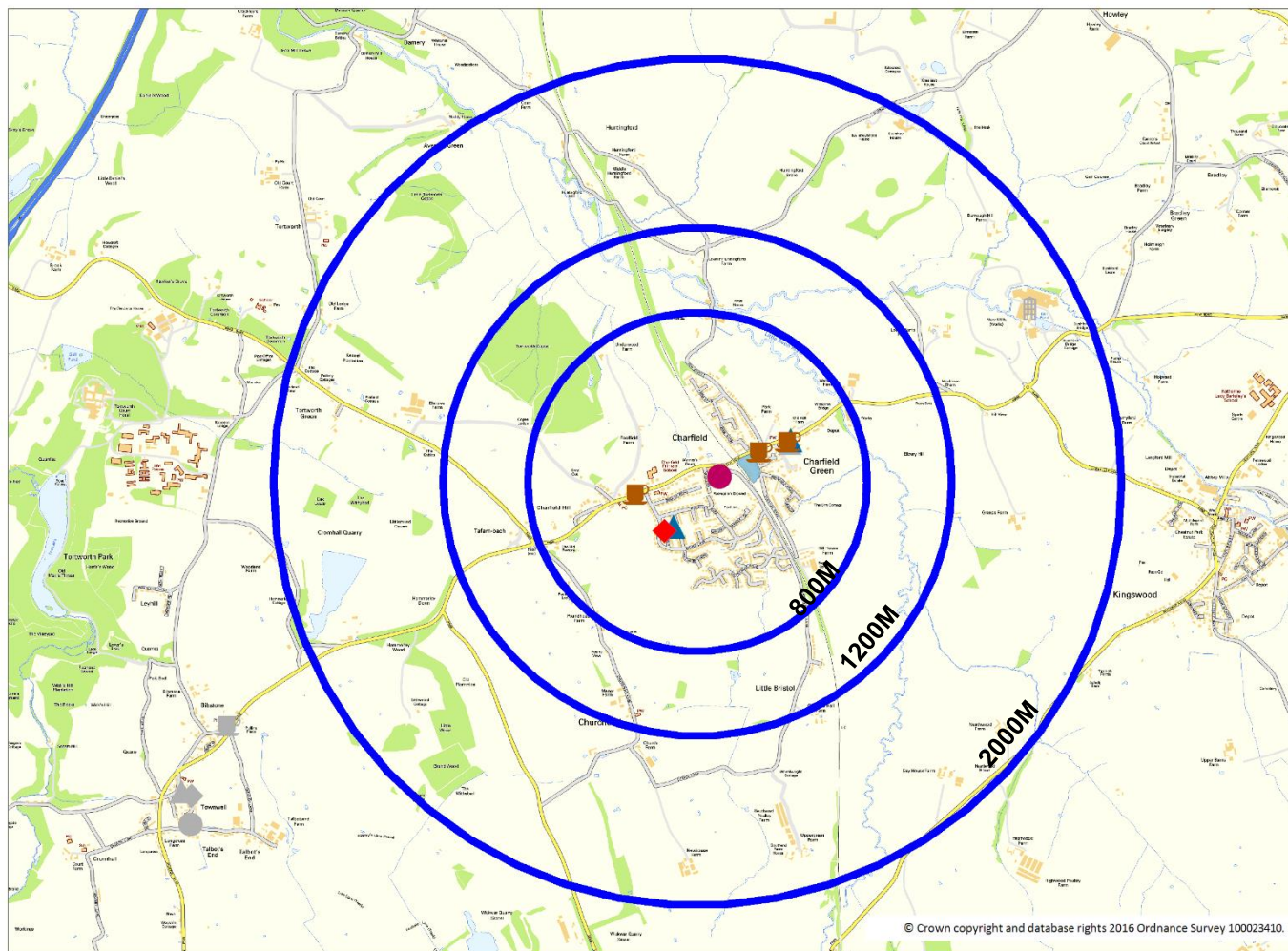
The map to the right shows three separate walking and cycling distances (800m, 1200m and 2000m) represented by blue rings.

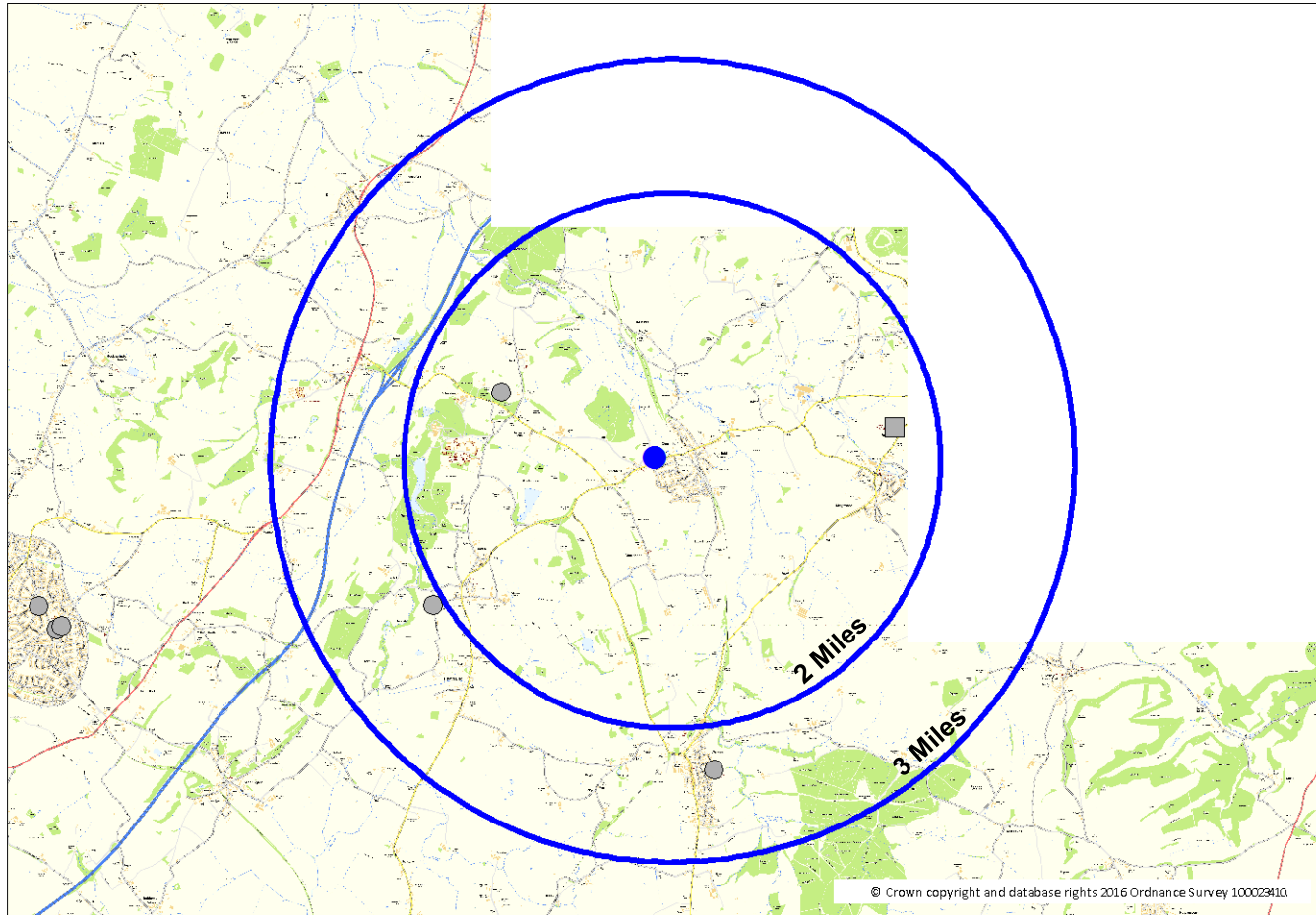

CONSULTATION CHANGES

A Rural Settlements and Villages 2015 Topic Paper was subject to public consultation in November 2015, separately in January 2017 Sustainable Access Profiles were made available for public consultation. A range of comments were received on the type of key services & facilities included. Comments on key services & facilities considered accessible from individual settlements were also received. Key changes made to the range of key services and facilities include:

CONSULTATION COMMENTS AND UPDATES

Facility	Justification
Major Employer – Walking, cycling route quality and usability	<p>Comments on the 2015 Topic Paper stressed the need to consider route quality and usability to key services and facilities included.</p> <p>Renshaw PLC is a major employer located within 2000meters of Charfield, but not considered accessible due to lack of any dedicated walking and cycling along the road connecting Renshaw PLC to Charfield, the B4058, which has a 50mph speed limit. The major employer is not therefore included as a service and facility accessible by walking and cycling from Charfield.</p>
Primary School & Secondary Schools– Walking, cycling route quality and usability	<p>Consultation comments on the 2015 Topic Paper stressed the need to consider route quality and usability to key services and facilities, in addition to the distance, particularly for education facilities. Tortworth VC Primary School lies within the 2 mile primary school catchment. However is not considered accessible as no dedicated walking and cycling routes exist along the B4509. The school is therefore not included as a service and facility accessible by walking or cycling.</p> <p>Katharine Lady Berkeley's School lies within an adjacent authority within the 3 mile secondary school catchment. However no safe route existing to facilitate walking or cycling to the school from Charfield. The school is therefore not included as a service and facility accessible by walking or cycling.</p>
Mobile Libraries	<p>As a result of consultation comments on the 2015 Topic Paper, relating to the lack of frequency, limited availability in many areas mobile libraries have been removed from the list of key services and facilities.</p>
