



Statement of Reasons

New Charlton Way, Catbrain Hill and Catbrain Lane (Patchway Ward) Proposed Waiting Restrictions

Background

Representations have been made to the Council to introduce additional waiting restrictions to deter motorists from parking during the weekday and deter motorists from parking at inappropriate locations such as junctions and roundabouts.

Purpose of Scheme

To protect junctions and roundabouts from inappropriate parking behaviour, whilst allowing local residents the opportunity to park without restraint during the evening and at the weekend. Time limited waiting restrictions would deter all-day parking during the week at some locations

Proposed Scheme

To install additional at any time waiting restrictions (double yellow lines) on sections of New Charlton Way and Catbrain Hill to protect junctions, a turning head and the roundabouts.

To install part-time waiting restrictions (single yellow lines) operating Monday to Friday between the hours of 2pm and 3pm, in sections of New Charlton Way and Catbrain Lane to protect residents from any commuter parking displaced from New Charlton Way.
