



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL (RECTORY ROAD, FRAMPTON COTTERELL AND WOTTON ROAD, IRON ACTON - PROTECTION OF SCHOOL ENTRANCES) (PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 201(-)

STATEMENT OF REASONS

Background

School keep clear markings outside Frampton Cotterell and Iron Acton Schools were introduced in 2016 without a Traffic Regulation Order because revised traffic sign legislation removed the need for Traffic Regulation Orders for these markings. Subsequent advice released by the Department for Transport indicates that a Traffic Regulation Order will now be required to accord with other legislation.

Purpose of the Scheme

The purpose of the scheme is to improve the safety outside of the schools and make the advisory School keep clear markings mandatory.

Proposed Scheme

The proposed scheme is to advertise proposals to introduce a supporting Traffic Regulation Order to make the existing road markings and signs legally enforceable.
