



## **Statement of Reasons**

### **Wellesley School – Waiting restriction review**

#### **Background**

In May 2014 concerns were raised by one of the local ward councillors that there were parking issues outside Wellesley Primary School in Edgeworth, Yate. The Council's Assess and Decide Team conducted a site visit and observed the parking spaces filling up very quickly and then parents parking on the advisory 'No Stopping' zig zag markings and across residents' garages and driveways.

A scheme was subsequently added to the Council's Local Transport Priority List to conduct a waiting restriction review of the area which would give consideration to formal no stopping and parking restrictions. The scheme was selected for inclusion in the Council's Local Transport Capital Programme 2018-19.

#### **Purpose of Scheme**

The purpose of the scheme is to improve safety outside the School and restrict areas where dangerous or obstructive parking takes place.

#### **Proposed Scheme**

It is proposed to replace the advisory keep clear markings and the advisory yellow zig zag markings around the roundabout with a no waiting at any time (double yellow lines) restriction, as well as replacing the remaining advisory yellow zig zags with a no waiting at specified days/times (single yellow lines) restriction.

The proposed days and times of operation for the no waiting at specified days/times (single yellow lines) restriction are Monday to Friday between 8am and 9.30am and 2.30pm until 4.30pm.

#### **Drawing Reference**

#### **Timescale**

Any proposals may only be implemented after reviewing the comments received during informal consultation and following public advertisement of a Traffic Regulation Order. The council will give consideration to any objections to the traffic regulation order before the order is made, and will then arrange for installation which would potentially be during 2020.
