

SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL

(A4174 FILTON ROAD AND B4058 BRISTOL ROAD, HAMBROOK) (PROHIBITION OF
RIGHT TURN) (PRESCRIBED LEFT TURN) (BUS LANE SUSPENSION) EXPERIMENTAL
ORDER 2019

The South Gloucestershire District Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under section 9 and section 10 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following order:-

1. This order shall come into operation on the 11 August 2019 and may be cited as the South Gloucestershire Council (A4174 Filton Road and B4058 Bristol Road, Hambrook) (Prohibition of Right Turn) (Prescribed Left Turn) (Bus Lane Suspension) Experimental Order 2019.
2. (1) In this Order "motor vehicle" has the same meaning as in section 136 of the Act of 1984.

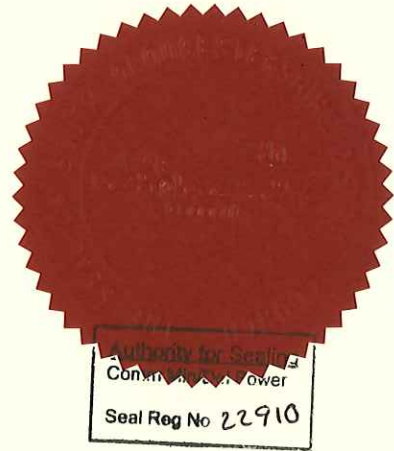

(2) Any reference in this order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
3. In this order "**A4174 Filton Road**" means that length of road which may also be known as A4174 Avon Ring Road.
4. No person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle proceeding in a westerly direction in the westbound carriageway of the **A4174 Filton Road** to make a right turn into the B4058 Bristol Road.
5. Every person causing or permitting any motor vehicle to proceed in a northerly direction in that length of the northbound carriageway of **B4058 Bristol Road** shall cause or permit every motor vehicle, on reaching the junction with A4174 Filton Road, to make a left turn into the westbound carriageway of the A4174 Filton Road.
6. The South Gloucestershire Council (A4174 Hambrook) (Reserved Bus Lane) Order 1998 as varied by the South Gloucestershire Council (A4174 Avon Ring Road and Bromley Heath Road, Hambrook) (High Occupancy Vehicle Lane) (Peak Hours) 1999, the South Gloucestershire Council (Variation of Bus Lane Orders - Definitions) Order 2002, the South Gloucestershire Council (Civil Parking Enforcement) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Off Street Parking Places) (Bus Lanes) Minor Order 2008 and the South Gloucestershire Council (A4174 Hambrook) (Reserved Bus Lane) (Variation) Order 2014 is hereby suspended.
7. If it appears to the Council's Director of Environment and Community Services, or some person, authorised by him, essential in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by the order runs and after consulting with the chief officer of police, he may modify or suspend any provision of this order, save that no modification shall make an addition.

In so far as any provision of this order conflicts with any provision of any order made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 and which imposes a restriction or prohibition on waiting by vehicles or grants an exemption from such restriction or prohibition then that provision of this Order shall prevail.
9. The provisions of this order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from the provisions of any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.
