**Proposed Watermore School Area Waiting Restriction Review, Frampton Cotterell**

I am writing to you as you may be affected by a traffic scheme in your area. Following redevelopment of Watermore Junior School site, it is proposed to review waiting restrictions in the area, including:

- a) Modification of School Keep Clear zig-zags on Lower Stone Close, to provide a safe crossing point for the Patrol, and restrict parking outside the school entrance
- b) Removal of redundant School Keep Clear zig-zags on Woodend Road
- c) Replacement of existing advisory keep clear markings with enforceable restrictions
- d) Introduction of waiting restrictions to prevent parking on junctions and across vehicle entrances
- e) Provide 2 hour maximum limited waiting outside the shops on Lower Stone Close, to maintain a turnover of vehicles for shop customers
