

**SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL**  
**(VARIOUS ROADS, PARKWALL AND WARMLEY WARD) (RESIDENTS' AND SHARED USE**  
**PARKING PLACES) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 2017[-]**

**Details of the proposed changes**

NOTICE is hereby given that South Gloucestershire District Council proposes to make an order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 46A, 49 and 51 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended the effect of which will be to:

- a) prohibit vehicles waiting at any time in lengths of A420 HIGH STREET, CHAPEL CLOSE, CHAPEL LANE, DEANERY ROAD, STATION CLOSE and TOWER ROAD NORTH, Warmley;
- b) prohibit vehicles waiting at any time on the verge or footway in a length A420 HIGH STREET, Warmley;
- c) prohibit vehicles waiting between the hours of 8am and 4pm on Monday to Saturday (inclusive) in a length of STATION CLOSE, Warmley
- d) restrict any vehicle waiting between the hours of 8am and 6pm on Monday to Saturday (inclusive), two hours with no return within four hours in a length of BADEN ROAD, Warmley;
- e) introduce Shared Use Parking Places in lengths of A420 HIGH STREET, CHAPEL LANE and TOWER ROAD NORTH, Warmley; and
- f) vary or revoke the orders specified in the schedule to this notice the provisions of which will be consolidated into the new order subject to items a) to e) above.

Full details of the proposal are contained in the draft order. If you would like to see a copy of the draft order, a map, any orders to be varied/revoked and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the order, you may do so at the Kingswood One Stop Shop, Kingswood Civic Centre, Kingswood and at Emersons Green Public Library, Emersons Way, Emersons Green, South Gloucestershire during normal opening hours.
