**Details of the proposed changes**

NOTICE is hereby given that South Gloucestershire District Council proposes to make an order under sections 82(2), 83(2) and 84(1) and (2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended the effect of which will be to:

- 1) introduce a 20 mph speed limit a) in **Church Road, Cookes Drive, Gable Close, Home Farm Way, Main Road (B4055), Prospect Close, Spaniorum View, The Lane, Easter Compton** and b) in **Chessell Avenue, Cranmoor Green, Cross Hands Lane, Cross Hands Road (B4055), Jackson Close, Keen's Grove, Northwick Road, Old Cross Hands Road Access to 57 to 65 and Village Hall, Redwick Road (B4064), The Glebe, Vicarage Road and Wainbridge Crescent, Pilning;**
- 2) introduce a 40 mph speed limit in a length of **B4055 Marsh Common Road;**
- 3) revoke the County Council of Gloucestershire (Built up Areas) Order, (No. 2) 1938 in so far as it relates to the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice the provisions of which will be consolidated into the new order subject to item 1) above;
- 4) revoke the South Gloucestershire Council (Various Roads, Pilning) (30 mph Speed Limit) (40 mph Speed Limit) (50 mph Speed Limit) Order 2011 in so far as it relates to the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice in favour of the measures in item 2) above.
