



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, EASTER COMPTON, MARSH COMMON AND PILNING) (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (RESTRICTED ROAD) ORDER 201[-]

STATEMENT OF REASONS

Background

Concerns have been raised by members of the public, Parish Councils and local Councillors regarding traffic speeds on the B4055 in Easter Compton, Pilning and in between the two villages.

Capital funding has been secured to provide traffic calming in Easter Compton. In addition, developer funding is available for a 20 mph zone with further traffic calming in Easter Compton, a 20 mph zone with traffic calming in Pilning and a reduction in the speed limit between the villages from 50 mph down to 40 mph.

Purpose of Scheme

To reduce traffic speeds in and between Easter Compton and Pilning.

Proposed Scheme

To introduce a 20 mph Zone in Easter Compton and Pilning.

To install 1 speed table and 8 sets of speed cushions in Easter Compton.

To install 5 sets of speed cushions in Pilning.

To reduce the 50 mph speed limit between Easter Compton and Pilning down to 40 mph.
