Westerleigh Crematorium Pedestrian Improvement Scheme

I am writing to you as you may be affected by a traffic scheme in your area.

It is proposed to construct new footways on both sides of Westerleigh Road within the verge outside the Crematorium where an existing and new proposed bus stop is to be sited. Additional measures such as two new 7 metre bus boarders, an uncontrolled crossing facility with dropped tactile kerbs and a pedestrian refuge are also proposed within the overall design of the scheme.
