

ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR CRIME AND POLICING ACT 2014

SECTION 59 - PUBLIC SPACES PROTECTION ORDER

(DRAFT) South Gloucestershire (Kennedy Way Underpass) Public Space Protection Order 2019

SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL (the Council) in exercise of its powers under section 59 of the Anti-Social Behaviour Crime and Policing Act 2014 (the Act), being satisfied that the anti-social behaviour arising in the underpass, has or will have a detrimental effect on the quality of life of those in the locality, makes the following order:

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this order no person shall use the right of ways specified in Schedule 1 to this order and shown on the plan attached to this order by a bold solid line at any time.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any person whose interests are identified as those protected by the Act. Statutory undertakers with plant or equipment in the area and emergency services will be exempt from the order.
3. An alternative route is specified in Schedule 2 to the order and shown on the plan attached to this order by a dashed line.
4. A barrier will be installed at each end of the affected rights of way. Contact details of the person responsible for maintaining and operating any barrier whose installation is authorised by the order are: Street Care, South Gloucestershire Council. Tel 01454 868000.
5. This order shall come into operation on the (date to be confirmed), and remain in force for a period of three years.

SCHEDULE 1

The route to be restricted is the underpass crossing Kennedy Way, Yate from near Sundridge Park to South Parade, Yate Shopping Centre.

SCHEDULE 2

The alternative route is via Sundridge Park and Kennedy Way, or the surface pedestrian crossing on Kennedy Way approximately 60 metres to the east of the underpass.
