SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, CHARLTON HAYES) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 202(-)

STATEMENT OF REASONS

Background

A new school, Charlton Wood Primary Academy has been built within the Charlton Hayes Housing Development bounded by Borkley Street, Wood Street and Charlton Boulevard. This school opened in September 2019 and will have an eventual enrolment of 420 pupils.

To ensure safety of the pupils and other road users the Council is proposing to introduce enforceable school keep clear markings on Borkley Street adjacent to the pedestrian entrances to the school. In addition to control parking in the vicinity of the school the Council proposes to introduce No Waiting at Any Time restrictions in parts of Borkley Street, Charlton Boulevard and Wood Street.

Purpose of Scheme

To introduce School Keep Clear Markings at the pedestrian entrances to Charlton Wood Primary Academy on Borkley Street, Charlton Hayes and Waiting Restrictions in Borkley Street, Charlton Boulevard and Wood Street, Charlton Hayes.

Proposed Scheme

- Borkley Street - School Keep Clear Mon-Fri 8am – 5pm
- Borkley Street - No Waiting At Any Time
- Charlton Boulevard - No Waiting At Any Time
- Wood Street - No Waiting At Any Time
