A. Details of the proposed changes:

Proposed changes to Waiting Restrictions

Roads affected: **Southmead Road, Filton**

South Gloucestershire Council (Southmead Road, Filton) (Prohibition of Waiting) Experimental Order 2020

Reference: **L3/DFA/STOP/PT.6650**

The Council made an order the effect of which is to prohibit vehicles waiting at any time in the length of **Southmead Road**, north side, Filton which extends from the City of Bristol County Boundary in a north easterly direction for a distance of 636 metres.
