

## NOTICE OF MAKING OF AN ORDER

### HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

#### SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL (FOOTPATH LSO 47 (PART), REAR OF CHAPEL LANE, OLD SODBURY) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER 2020

The above order, made on 19 August 2020, under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will divert the length of public footpath LSO 47 in the Parish of Sodbury running from the field boundary at its junction with public footpath LSO/40/10 at Point A (grid ref ST 7502 8133) in a generally south easterly direction across several plots of land for 323m to Point B (grid ref ST 7516 8104) where it meets Chapel Lane as shown on the order map by a bold black line marked A – B to a line running from Point C (grid ref ST 7517 8118) at its junction with Chapel Lane between property numbers 76 and 78 running along a tarmac surfaced path in a generally south south westerly direction for a distance of 97m to point D (grid ref ST 7517 8109) where it re-joins Chapel Lane at the Landcare Nursery boundary as shown on the order map by a bold broken line marked C – D.

A copy of the order, the order map and an explanatory statement have been placed and may be seen free of charge at the Yate One Stop Shop (next to the Leisure Centre), Kennedy Way, Yate during normal offices hours, however, due to Covid-19 restrictions an appointment should first be made by telephoning 01454 868009. Please note that all representations received may be considered in public by the Council and that the substance of any representation together with the name and address of the person making it could become available for public inspection.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, South Gloucestershire District Council may confirm the order as an unopposed order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
