



## Statement of Reasons

# FRENCHAY – Beckspool Road Traffic Calming Review

### Background

Developers of the former Frenchay Hospital site have recently installed traffic calming features on Beckspool Road, and concerns have been raised by residents and motorists to address the safety and effectiveness of the current features.

### Purpose of Scheme

To provide traffic calming to support the current 20mph zone and promote lower speeds, whilst adding and removing any unnecessary restrictions to allow free flowing traffic and parking within the vicinity of Frenchay Common.

### Proposed Scheme

To install 5 speed tables that replicate the existing speed tables north of Beckspool Road, which will be supported by waiting restrictions to encourage free flowing traffic and allow parking. It is also proposed to install new wooden bollards to increase visibility.

### Drawing Reference

Drawing number T437-576-002 shows the existing arrangement and drawing T437-576-003 shows the proposed traffic calming and waiting restrictions.

### Timescale

Subject to the comments received at consultation and public advertisement, it is expected that the proposals will be implemented during the 2021-22 financial year.
