

## **SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL**

### **(HERON WAY, YATE) (30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 202(-)**

The South Gloucestershire District Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under sections 84(1) and (2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following order:-

1. The County Council of Avon (Various Road, Yate and Chipping Sodbury, District of Northavon) (Restricted Roads) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 1988 by virtue of which the length of road specified in the Schedule to this order became subject to a 40 miles per hour speed limit is hereby revoked in so far as it relates to that length of road.
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the roads and lengths of road identified as **"30 MPH"** on drawing reference **T409-121-04** annexed to this order.
3. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
