**(LITTLETON DREW LANE, ACTON TURVILLE - PROTECTION OF SCHOOL**  
**ENTRANCES) (PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 202(-)**

**Details of the proposed changes**

NOTICE is hereby given that South Gloucestershire District Council proposes to make an order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(1) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended the effect of which will be to protect areas marked with school entrance markings in accordance with the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 in lengths of **Littleton Drew Lane**, Acton Turville, in the vicinity of Trinity C of E Primary School, by prohibiting any vehicle stopping during the restricted hours which will be the hours shown on traffic signs placed at that location.

Exemptions in the order permit any vehicle to wait for the purpose of building or demolition works; removal of obstruction to traffic; maintenance of the road; supply of gas, water or electricity; the pursuance of statutory powers or duties and fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.
