

## **ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR CRIME AND POLICING ACT 2014**

### **SECTION 59 - PUBLIC SPACES PROTECTION ORDER**

#### **(DRAFT) South Gloucestershire (Tanhouse Lane) Public Space Protection Order 2021**

SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL (the Council) in exercise of its powers under section 59 of the Anti-Social Behaviour Crime and Policing Act 2014 (the Act), being satisfied that the anti-social behaviour arising in the spur off Tanhouse Lane, has or will have a detrimental effect on the quality of life of those in the locality, makes the following order:

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this order no person shall use a motor vehicle on the length of public highway specified in Schedule 1 to this order and shown on the plan attached to this order by a bold solid line at any time.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any person whose interests are identified as those protected by the Act. Statutory undertakers with plant or equipment in the area and emergency services will be exempt from the order.
3. Pedestrians, cyclists and equestrian use of the lane are not restricted by this order.
4. An earth bund will be installed at the junction with Tanhouse Lane. Contact details of the person responsible for maintaining this are: Street Care, South Gloucestershire Council. Tel 01454 868000.
5. This order shall come into operation on the (date to be confirmed), and remain in force for a period of three years.

#### **SCHEDULE 1**

The route to be restricted is the spur off Tanhouse Lane, Yate running in a southerly direction for approximately 200 metres.

#### **SCHEDULE 2**

No alternative vehicle route is provided as this is a no-through road.
