

## A4174 Junction Improvement Scheme: Have your say on the proposed junction improvements

The A4174 Ring Road is a key transport corridor in South Gloucestershire providing a link between the A4 and Bath to the south and the M32 and the M4 to the north. The ring road also provides access to local residential and employment areas.

We have investigated options to improve the layout of five junctions on the A4174 Ring Road between the Lyde Green and Kingsfield Roundabouts. This is part of a wider package of improvements to ring road junctions proposed in the Joint Local Transport Plan 4 (2020 – 2036) for the West of England.
