



## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

### SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, STOKE GIFFORD - PHASE 4A) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 202(-)

#### STATEMENT OF REASONS

##### **Background**

Funding has been secured to carry out an area wide waiting restriction review for the Stoke Gifford ward, and with the ward being quite a large area it has been decided to split the review into 3 phases, phase 4A, 4B and 4C. This particular consultation is focusing on phase 4A.

Following meetings and site visits with the local councillors and a review of requests that have been received over a period of time, it is proposed to introduce waiting restrictions to alleviate obstructive and inconsiderate parking on various roads within Stoke Gifford to improve safety and visibility for all road users and pedestrians.

##### **Purpose of Scheme**

The purpose of the scheme is to address the obstructive and inconsiderate parking on the identified roads and to accommodate additional parking provisions.

##### **Proposed Scheme**

The proposed scheme is to introduce double yellow lines to improve access and visibility on roads that have been identified and to convert existing advisory white keep clear lines to double yellow lines.

Additional parking provisions are also included within the review which consist of an increase of limited waiting for two existing on street bays from 2 hours to 4 hours to allow motorists to park for longer whilst visiting local businesses.

There are also some existing double yellow lines that are currently implemented on the ground which unfortunately, are not contained within a sealed Traffic Regulation Order (TRO). Therefore, it would be appropriate to include these existing double yellow lines in the new TRO by proposing that they are new double yellow lines, as shown on the proposal plans. This is to ensure that they are advertised and made legally enforceable. The affected sections of road are scheduled below;

- South west of Parkway roundabout on Hunts Ground Road.
- South west of Simmonds View across the access to industrial area.

The affected roads are scheduled below;

- Adelante Close
- Bakers Ground
- Manor Place
- Newbrick Road

- Castle Court
- County Way
- Halls Garden
- Hunts Ground Road
- Kings Drive
- Riviera Way
- Star Avenue
- Simmonds View
