

## **SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL**

### (HIGH STREET, THORNBURY) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 202(-)

The South Gloucestershire District Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1) and 2(1) to (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following order:-

1. This order shall come into operation on the \_\_\_\_\_ and may be cited as the South Gloucestershire Council (High Street, Thornbury) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 202(-).

2. (1) In this Order:-

"disabled person" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 as amended by the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2000;

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 as amended by the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2000;

"disabled persons' parking place" means an area on a road designated for use only by a disabled person's vehicle;

"disabled persons vehicle" means:

- (a) a vehicle which is lawfully displaying a disabled person's badge in the relevant position and is a vehicle which, immediately before or after any period of waiting allowed by a provision of this order, has been or is to be driven by a disabled person or, as the case may be, has been or is to be used for carrying one or more disabled persons as passengers; or
- (b) an invalid carriage as prescribed in Section 136 of the Act of 1984;

"electronic communications apparatus" means apparatus comprised in or to be comprised in an electronic communications network as defined in the Communications Act 2003;

"goods" means goods of any kind whether animate or inanimate and includes postal packets of any description;

"motor vehicle" has the same meaning as in section 136 of the Act of 1984;

"plans" means the drawings which are annexed hereto as specified in the Schedule to this order;

"traffic warden" means a traffic warden employed by a police authority in pursuance of sections 95 and 96 of the Act of 1984 and any powers or functions given to a traffic warden in this order may also be exercised by a police officer in uniform; and

"vehicle" means any vehicle, whether or not it is in a fit state for use on a road, and includes chassis or body, with or without wheels, appearing to have formed part of such a vehicle, and any load carried by and anything attached to such a vehicle.

- (2) Any reference in this order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
3. Save as provided in Article 5 of this order no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to enter, proceed or wait in the lengths of road identified as "**Prohibition of Motor Vehicles**" in the plans.
4. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road identified as "**One Way**" in the plans other than in a southerly direction.
5. (1) Nothing in Article 3 of this order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to enter, proceed or wait in the length of road referred to therein if the vehicle is being used:
  - a. in connection with the carrying out on, or on premises situated on that length of road of any of the following operations, namely:-
    - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
    - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
    - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road;
    - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to the road of any sewer, or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or any telecommunication apparatus as defined in the Communications Act 2003;
  - b. In the service of a local authority, the Environment Agency, a water undertaker or sewerage undertaker in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
  - c. For goods to be loaded on or unloaded from a vehicle

provided that any such motor vehicle proceeds only in a southerly direction.

- (2) Nothing in Article 3 of this order shall apply to any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes in exercise of official duties.
- (3) Nothing in Article 3 of this order shall apply to any motor vehicle necessarily proceeding to or from any premises situated on or accessible only from the length of road referred to therein provided that any such vehicle proceeds only in a southerly direction.

- (4) Nothing in Article 3 of this order shall apply to any disabled persons' vehicle accessing a disabled persons' parking place provided that any such vehicle proceeds only in a southerly direction.
- (5) Nothing in Article 3 of this order shall apply to any motor vehicle accessing a limited waiting parking place provided that any such vehicle proceeds only in a southerly direction.
- 6. The provisions of this order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from the provisions of any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.
