

**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER**

**TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 - SECTION 257**  
**AND PARAGRAPH 7 OF SCHEDULE 14**

**SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL**  
**(FOOTPATH LYA 53 (PART) AT NORTH YATE - NEW NEIGHBOURHOOD) PUBLIC**  
**PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2021**

On the 29 September 2021 South Gloucestershire District Council confirmed the above order.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to divert that length of public footpath LYA 53, Yate which runs from Point S (grid reference ST 7088 8517) on Tanhouse Lane in a southerly direction for a distance of 424 metres to Point L (grid reference ST 7093 8476) where it meets the unaffected part of public footpath LYA 53, shown by a bold black line marked S - L on the order map to a new line running from the said Point S where it meets the adopted highway on Tanhouse Lane running in a south easterly direction for 10 metres then in a southerly direction for 161 metres to Point R (grid reference ST 7089 8501), where it crosses an estate road turning west south west for 5 metres to Point Q (grid reference ST 7089 8501), then south for 12 metres to Point P (grid reference ST 7089 8500) then running east for 5 metres to Point O (grid reference ST 7089 8500) before returning to a southerly direction alongside an estate road for a distance of 240 metres to Point N (grid reference ST 7092 8476) where it crosses the estate road in an easterly direction for a distance of 11 metres to Point L (grid reference ST 7093 8476) where it meets the unaffected part of LYA 53, having a width throughout of 2 metres and shown by a bold broken line marked S - R - Q - P - O - N - L on the order map.

This order comes into force on the date which South Gloucestershire District Council certify that the terms of Article 2 of the order have been complied with but if any person aggrieved by the order desires to question its validity or that of any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers of above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the order, he or she may apply to the High Court for any of these purposes under section 287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 within six weeks from the date on which notice is first published as required by paragraph 7 of Schedule 14 to that Act.
