

Developing proposals for a new Jubilee Park

In February 2022 South Gloucestershire Council announced proposals to create a new Jubilee Park in Cadbury Heath to celebrate the Queens Platinum Jubilee and in memory of HRH Duke of Edinburgh and his interest in wildlife and nature with the aim to promote biodiversity and nature recovery.

Improvements will centre on landscaping and sympathetic planting for biodiversity, access improvements for all and signage.

The proposed scheme will look to utilize and enhance one existing open space in the Cadbury Heath area to create a space where residents and visitors can relax and enjoy the new amenity.

Three potential existing green spaces sites in Cadbury Heath have been shortlisted for the park location, and we are asking residents to help us identify which location they prefer and why.
