

SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL

(AUST WHARF, AUST) (30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 202(-)

The South Gloucestershire District Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under sections 84(1) and (2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following order:-

1. The South Gloucestershire Council (Various Roads at Aust) (30 mph Speed Limit) (50 mph Speed Limit) Order 2008 by virtue of which the length of road specified in the Schedule to this order became subject to a speed limit of 50 miles per hour is hereby revoked, in so far as it relates to that length of road.
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the road and lengths of road identified as **"30mph Speed limit"** on drawing reference **T404-104-32 Rev A** annexed to this order.
3. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
4. This order shall come into operation on the _____ and may be cited as the South Gloucestershire Council (Aust Wharf, Aust) (30 mph Speed Limit) Order 202(-).

"That length of **Aust Warth** which extends from its junction with the A403 Severn Road to a point 5 metres south of its junction with Passage Road and Old Passage Road, a distance measured along the said length of road of approximately 925 metres"
