

SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL
(AUST WHARF, AUST) (30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 202(-)

Details of the proposed changes

NOTICE is hereby given that South Gloucestershire District Council proposes to make an order under sections 84(1) and (2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended the effect of which will be to:

- a) prohibit the driving of motor vehicles at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour in a length of **Aust Wharf**, Aust; and
- b) revoke the South Gloucestershire Council (Various Roads at Aust) (30 mph Speed Limit) (50 mph Speed Limit) Order 2008 in so far as it relates to **Aust Wharf**, Aust in favour of the provisions specified in item a) above.

Full details of the proposal are contained in the draft order.
