

**NOTICE OF MODIFICATION ORDER  
SECTION 53 OF THE WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981  
SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT**

**SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL (FOOTPATH BETWEEN GOLDNEY AVENUE  
AND LONDON ROAD AT WARMLEY) DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT  
MODIFICATION ORDER 2022**

The above Order made on 14 September 2022, if confirmed as made, will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by adding to them the footpath commencing at Point A (grid reference ST 6731 7335), where it joins with the adopted highway on Goldney Avenue, running in a west north westerly direction along a surfaced track adjacent to property number 10 and in front of property numbers 12 and 14, for a distance of 31 metres to Point Y (grid reference ST 6728 7336) where it passes through a gateway into a yard area and continues in a north westerly direction for a distance of 24 metres before curving round to a north north easterly direction, for a distance of 49 metres across a surfaced yard area alongside a warehouse then in a generally north north westerly direction for a further 36 metres, passing through a gateway at Point X (grid reference ST 6727 7344) and joining with the adopted highway on London Road at Point B (grid reference ST 6727 7346) between property numbers 8 and 10 London Road. Shown as a bold broken line marked A – Y – X - B on the order map. The width of the path is 3 metres throughout its length. The total length is 140 metres. The number of the footpath to be added is PSN61.

Any representation or objection relating to the order must be sent in writing to the Head of Legal, Governance and Democratic Services at the undermentioned address quoting reference L3/DFA/STOR/PT.6613 not later than 11 November 2022, and applicants are requested to state the grounds on which it is made. Please note that all representations received may be considered in public by the Council and that the substance of any representation together with the name and address of the person making it could become available for public inspection.

If no such representations or objections are duly made to the order, or if any so made are withdrawn, the South Gloucestershire District Council, instead of submitting the order to the Secretary of State may itself confirm the order. If the order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.
