



## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

### SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL (HIGH STREET, KINGSWOOD) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 202(-)

#### STATEMENT OF REASONS

##### **Background**

The scheme has been approved as part of the emergency active travel fund measures. The proposed waiting restrictions are part of these measures.

##### **Purpose of the scheme**

The purpose of this scheme is to provide a larger area outside the entrances of school for the students and parents to be able to move around with more ease.

These Traffic Regulation Orders are required to reflect the layout that is now on site.

##### **Proposed scheme**

The permanent proposal is to increase the width of the footway outside the old library by replacing the existing lay-by and extending the width of the footway in its place, while maintaining a disabled bay.
