

NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 - SECTION 257
AND PARAGRAPH 1 OF SCHEDULE 14
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981, SECTION 53A(2)

SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL
(FOOTPATH LWE39 (PART) BOX HEDGE FARM, COALPIT HEATH) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION
AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER 2022

The above order was made on 7 December 2022. The effect of the order will be to divert the public footpath running from that length of public footpath **LWE 39** in the Unitary District of South Gloucestershire in the Parish of Westerleigh from **Point A** (grid reference ST 6822 7971) where it leaves the unaffected part of footpath LWE 39 and running in a generally east north easterly direction, for a distance of 76 metres to **Point B** (grid reference ST 6830 7972), continuing through the field boundary in an east south easterly direction parallel to the line of the hedge for a distance of 108 metres to **Point C** (grid reference ST 6840 7969) where it meets the bridleway LWE 38 shown by a bold black line marked **A – B – C** as shown on the order map -

to a new line running from the said **Point A** (grid reference ST 6822 7971) where it leaves the unaffected part of footpath LWE 39 running in an easterly direction along a track for a distance of 46 metres to **Point D** (grid reference ST 6827 7970) adjacent to the corner of a building then turning to run in a southerly direction parallel with the field boundary for a distance of 51 metres to **Point E** (grid reference ST 6827 7965) then turning to continue in a south easterly direction for a distance of 27 metres to **Point F** (grid reference ST 6828 7963). Here it turns in an easterly direction to run on the north side of the field boundary fence for a distance 59 metres to **Point G** (grid reference ST 6834 7964) before it turns in a generally north easterly direction across the access track for a distance of 22 metres to **Point H** (grid reference ST 6835 7965) then turning east and then north east in a curve for a distance of 57 metres to **Point I** (grid reference ST 6840 7968). From here it turns northwards for 8 metres to terminate at **Point C** (grid reference ST 6840 7969) where it meets bridleway LWE 38. Having a width throughout of 2 metres and shown by a bold broken line marked **A – D – E – F – G – H – I – C** as shown on the order map.

A copy of the order and the order map and an explanatory statement have been placed and may be seen free of charge at Yate One Stop Shop (next to the Leisure Centre), Kennedy Way, Yate BS37 4DQ during normal offices hours. Any representation about or objection to the order may be sent or delivered in writing addressed to the Head of Legal and Democratic Services at the undermentioned address quoting reference L3/DFA/STOR/PT.7191 not later than 13 January 2023. Please state the grounds on which it is made. Please note that all representations received may be considered in public by the Council and that the substance of any representation together with the name and address of the person making it could become available for public inspection.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, South Gloucestershire District Council may itself confirm the order as an unopposed order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
