

SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL
(HEMPTON LANE, PATCHWAY) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) (PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) (VARIATION) ORDER 201[1]

Details of the proposed changes

NOTICE is hereby given that South Gloucestershire District Council proposes to make an order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(1) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended the effect of which will be to:

- 1) vary further the South Gloucestershire Council (Southern Brooks Area - South Gloucestershire) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Consolidation) Order 2008 so as to
 - a) prohibit any vehicle waiting at any time, subject to specified exemptions, in the length of road specified in Part 1 of Schedule 1 to this Notice, and
 - b) remove the existing 'No Waiting at any time' restriction in the length of road specified in Part II of Schedule 1 to this Notice.

- 2) vary further the South Gloucestershire Council (Various Roads - Protection of School Entrances) (Prohibition of Stopping) Order 2002 so as to protect areas marked with school entrance markings in accordance with the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 in the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice by prohibiting any vehicle stopping, subject to specified exemptions, during the restricted hours which will be the hours shown on traffic signs placed at that location.

Full details of the proposal are contained in the draft order. If you would like to see a copy of the draft order, a map any orders to be varied/revoked and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the order, you can do so at the address below during normal office hours. Alternatively, these items can also be inspected at Patchway Public Library, Rodway Road, Patchway, South Gloucestershire during normal opening hours. SCHEDULE 1

Part I

Proposed 'No Waiting At Any Time'

Hempton Lane

- north side - a) from 109.73m west of the A38 Gloucester Road westwards for 40.25m
- south side - b) from 315m west of the A38 Gloucester Road westwards for 87m
from 360m west of the A38 Gloucester Road westwards for 37m

Part II

Proposed 'No Waiting At Any Time' restriction to be removed

Hempton Lane

- south side - from 84m west of the A38 Gloucester Road westwards to 133.5 metres west of the A38 Gloucester Road

SCHEDULE 2

Protected School Entrance - No Stopping (subject to specified exemptions)

Restricted Hours – At All Times

Hempton Lane

- south side - *(Patchway Community College, Patchway)*
- from 84m west of the A38 Gloucester Road westwards for 60m
