

SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL
(VARIOUS ROADS, PARKWAY STATION AREA, STOKE GIFFORD)
(PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING) (VARIATION) ORDER 201[1]

Details of the proposed changes

NOTICE is hereby given that South Gloucestershire District Council proposes to make an order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended the effect of which will be to vary further the South Gloucestershire Council (Southern Brooks Area - South Gloucestershire) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Consolidation) Order 2008 so as to -

- a) prohibit any vehicle waiting at any time, subject to specified exemptions, in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this notice;
- b) prohibit any vehicle waiting between the hours of 10.00 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. on any day other than a Saturday or Sunday, subject to specified exemptions, in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice;
- c) restrict any vehicle waiting for more than 30 minutes in any one hour period between the hours of 1.00 p.m. and 2.00 p.m. on any day other than a Saturday or Sunday, subject to specified exemptions, in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 3 to this notice, and
- d) restrict any vehicle waiting for more than two hours in any four hour period between the hours of 3.00 p.m. and 6.00 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday, subject to specified exemptions, in the length of road specified in Schedule 4 to this notice.

Exemptions provided in item b) and item c) above will permit waiting by vehicles that display a written authorisation issued by South Gloucestershire Council.

Full details of the proposal are contained in the draft order. Proposed No Waiting At Any Time (currently unrestricted)

Church Road, Stoke Gifford

- north east side - a) from 113m south east of Westfield Lane south eastwards for 24m
b) from 176m south east of Westfield Lane south eastwards for 85m north west of Hambrook Lane
c) from 42m north west of Hambrook Lane to Hambrook Lane
- south west side - from 28m south east of Westfield Lane to Harry Stoke Road

Hambrook Lane

- north west side- from Church Road north eastwards for 125m
south west side - from Church Road north eastwards for 46.5m

Harry Stoke Road

- west side - from Church Road southwards for 225m
east side - from Church Road southwards for 9.5m

Highfields Close

- south west side - from Hambrook Lane north westwards for 9.5m

Hunts Ground Road

- east side - a) from 30m south west of the Parkway Roundabout to 242m south west of the said junction
b) from 315m from its junction with the western exit of Parkway Roundabout south westwards for 46 metres

Parkway North Roundabout

- all sides - entire length

Ratcliffe Drive

- west side - from 93m north of Hatchet Road to Constantine Avenue

Ratcliffe Drive (eastern section leading past Fabian Drive)

- north and north west side- a) from Ratcliffe Drive eastwards for 6.5m
b) from 15.5 metres east of Ratcliffe Drive eastwards for 6m
c) from 26 metres east of Ratcliffe Drive eastwards for 5m
d) from 39 metres east of Ratcliffe Drive eastwards for 5m
e) from 54 metres east of Ratcliffe Drive eastwards for 8m
f) from the common boundary of Property Nos. 100 and 104 Ratcliffe Drive generally north eastwards to 13m southwest of Fabian Drive
- south and east side - a) from 93m east of Ratcliffe Drive eastwards to 95m east of Ratcliffe Drive
b) from 42m south west of Fabian Drive south westwards for 6m

Church Road, Stoke Gifford

- north east side - a) from 26m south east of Westfield Lane to 28m south east of Westfield Lane (currently 'No Waiting At Any Time')
b) from 28m south east of Westfield Lane to 113m south east of Westfield Lane
