NOTICE is hereby given that South Gloucestershire District Council proposes to make an order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 4(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle other than a pedal cycle proceeding in Gloucester Road from making a left turn into Shellmor Avenue.
