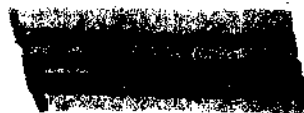

Additional Hearing.

It appears that the proposed hearing is, in part, to reconsider the alternative possible development of land at various sites which will probably include Agricultural land at Woodlands Farm, Coalpit Heath in the Parish of Westerleigh.

I trust that the Planning Officers and Committee will vigorously oppose any further development, particularly bearing in mind the extensive expansion of housing in the locality of Coalpit Heath. This has led to serious problems in support services - particularly sewers, access roads etc. Furthermore, much of the development in this area has taken place on good agricultural land when the need for home grown food has never been greater, bearing in mind city populations and the need to reduce expensive imports. Land drainage is also a problem.
