

Dear Mrs Thorne,

I wish to strongly object to the proposed development on the far side of Morton Way for the following reasons:-

1. I don't believe that there is a need for 300 new houses in Thornbury in addition to those proposed for Park Farm.
2. It is the wrong place to build additional house, once the boundary of Morton Way is breached it opens the way to even more development with no barrier except Gloucester and the Cotswold edge.
3. It is too far from town, further accentuating the lop sided bulge of Thornbury development away from the town centre. People living there would not walk to shop in Thornbury and once in the car would be more likely to go to one of the superstores on the outskirts of Bristol.
4. They are the wrong type of houses, what Thornbury needs is high quality small houses for the many older people in the community which could free up family houses for families.
