Dear Kath Thorne,

I am writing to express my concern and disagreement with the proposal to build 300 houses on Moreton Way, Thornbury.

The 500 new homes at Park Farm Estate will cause big problems on the already congested A.38. An extra 300 homes would mean 300 more cars, probably 400 to 450. There would have to be major changes to the Gloucester Road up to Falfield as well as Moreton Way, Butts Lane and Groveend Road. The impact on the countryside would be far wider than Moreton Way. People in all the new houses would have to travel away from Thornbury for work as there are not enough jobs in Thornbury.

Also the local health facilities, secondary school and leisure facilities will not be able to cope with the effects of new build at Park Farm. This situation would be made much worse by building a further 300 homes. Parking in Thornbury would be far more difficult.

These adverse effects would fuel resentment and anger amongst all residents of the area thus creating unrest and bitterness.

Please would you pass on these views to the Inspector in charge of the Core Strategy.
