It has been requested that Thornbury residents write to you concerning the proposal to build 300 more houses on the un-occupied side of Morton Way, despite this not being included in the original Core Strategy.

If this is done, all it will need is another development at the other end of the road to make a good case for "infilling", resulting in building free-for-all. It happens - goodbye Green Belt!

Such an expansion, in addition to the 500 houses already agreed in the Park Farm enlargement, would swamp the town.

People must live somewhere of course - I live on the original Park Farm estate - but careful consideration should first be given, not just to a house-building spree, but to the supporting infrastructure. Thornbury has one and a half supermarkets, a very small health centre and, at busy shopping times, very limited car parking. These facilities would not be enough to cater for another c.3000 inhabitants plus the associated traffic.
