

**Alan French - Possible 300 houses on Morton Way**

I wish to object to the proposal to build on the Green belt land adjacent to Morton Way for the following reasons ;-

Infrastructure such as car parks public facilities, roads would be overloaded. Oldbury Power Station is going to be decommissioned over the next twenty years which will involve a high traffic burden on roads leading to Oldbury ( Plant, machinery, heavy lorries and personnel involved). Also we hear of proposals to build another Nuclear Power Station very near to the Oldbury site, this will compound the traffic problem.

I would like to retain Morton Way as the boundary to housing development on the north east side of town.I feel that any further development on such a scale would make Thornbury more like Bradley Stoke or Yate.

I think it is criminal to use more green belt land such as that bordering Morton Way. Extra houses mean more school places, Thornbury is at present strangled with traffic during the school run, obviously this would get worse with extra houses further away from schools. Morton way is just beyond walking distance for shoppers, so cars would be used.

Thornbury is a pleasant market town with no room for development in the town centre, its difficult to find car parking on most week days & Saturday at the moment.
