I am writing to express my dismay regarding the proposed building of houses on Morton way Thornbury, I am completely opposed to this proposal.

I have been a resident of Thornbury for 30 years. I agree that new housing is needed in Thornbury otherwise the town is likely to "die". For this reason I support the building of houses at Park Farm. It should be possible to integrate the occupants of these 500 houses into the existing infrastructure without too many problems.

Building an additional 300 houses WILL HAVE a significant impact on the existing infrastructure and is likely to cause significant problems and difficulties.

In addition once the Morton Way "boundary" is breached there is likely to be more and more housing which will completely alter the nature of Thornbury.

I therefore request that the plan to build houses on Morton way be rejected at this time.
