

Subject: Morton Way houses.

Dear Mr Thorne,

I am writing to register our opposition to the proposal to build 300 new houses on the green fields alongside Morton Way, Thornbury. We have just moved into Thornbury (3 months ago) and we did so because the boundary to the town is defined by fields alongside the Morton Way 'ring-road' which is close to our property - a feature of this beautiful market town.

I am still a Parish Councillor at Alveston and am aware of the work which has gone into the development of the Core Strategy as regards housing and in particular believe that the proposals at Park Farm are adequate for Thornbury's future town growth. I am particularly concerned that should these houses be built, against the wishes of the vast majority of residents, it will inevitably lead to further development along Morton Way and the boundary to the town and its associated green fields will be lost for ever. One could even envisage new housing development also extending along Midland Way!!

I strongly urge that the Morton Way housing boundary be retained. No new houses please in this area.
