Subject: Gordon Hall - Morton Way Development

For the attention of Ms. Kath Thomas,

I would like to add my voice to the protests against the proposal to develop Morton Way as well as the site on Park Farm. Having 500 houses built on the Park Farm site is overwhelming for a small town like Thornbury and then want to build a further 300 on the Morton Way site is way beyond the limit. My objections are based on the following:-

Assuming every household has at least one car that is an extra 300 vehicles - on top of the possible 500 from the Park Farm development - using the local roads which, even now, are congested at peak times.

Local facilities, such as schools, surgeries, and other public utilities are only just adequate now. 500 more families in the town requiring them is bad enough and with the proposal to add a further 300 to this area is going to be disastrous.

I cannot see the developers making adequate arrangements for the necessary infrastructure like roads, car parking, and all other requirements needed for the massive development in Thornbury.
