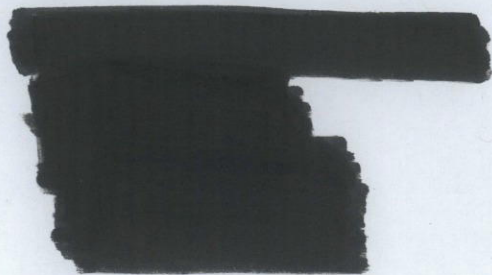

Dear Ms. Thorne,
re: extra 300 houses on Morton Way

I am writing to urge you to re-consider apparent plans to build an additional 300 houses off Morton Way. I fully support building new homes in Thornbury for people to live in and to help the town develop. However, this extra 300 houses proposed is too large an increase (almost 25%) to the size of the town and therefore threatens its character and

thriving sense of community.

In addition, I, like many others, feel that breaching the natural boundary of Morton Way sets a dangerous precedent, opening the way for sprawling development. This could spoil the town and put too much pressure on existing infrastructure.

I therefore urge that the extra 300 houses is very carefully considered and suggest that 500 is enough for now.
