Proposal to build 300 more houses in Thornbury.

I write to OPPOSE the new plan to build 300 more houses in Thornbury above the agreed South Gloucestershire Core Strategy.

I oppose for the following reasons: -

- 1) Thornbury's facilities will be stretched to contain the occupants of the extra 500 houses already planned on The Farm Park estate.
- 2) Housing on the outskirts of a town means the occupants will inevitably drive in by car - and there is already a car parking problem, and no space internally to build more
- 3) Morton Way is a well marked boundary to the town. Once breached there will be no stopping developers spreading over the green fields beyond it. Morton Way should remain a boundary.
