

Both my wife [Susan Feltham] and myself [Barry Feltham] are utterly opposed to the building of houses on Morton Way Thornbury.

We have lived in Thornbury for 45 years and my grandparents werer originally from the area.

The core strategy has been set and although I personally do not agree with some of the plan, it has been passed.

By looking to build more houses we are looking at a total development of 800 houses , 500 is too many but 800 will just swamp the area,

services such as doctors ,dentists and schools will not cope and will prompt more building, always supposing staff can be found.

Jobs will not be available in the area so most will have to commute. The A38 in towards Bristol is mostly very slow moving in the mornings

and evenings this will only get worse.

Finally Morton way has been seen as a natural boundry for Thornbury and are green fields producing produce, be it beef, potatoes or cereals
