Please register my disapproval of the tentative plan to meet the Inspector's requirement for an additional 800 houses in S. Glos. by cramming 300 houses on the Morton Way site. I like many other people in Thornbury do not wish to see the Morton Way proposal to go ahead as this will blight the character of this attractive market town - the reason I chose to settle here 30 years ago. Morton Way provides a natural boundary to the limit of development on that side of the town. Building beyond this boundary will destroy all the character of the town and risk development sprawling out of control. The infrastructure will not support such a development and recent flooding in the area shows what a delicate balance exists around the town and how concreting over nearby fields will only lead to further problems.
