I wish to object most strongly to the proposed housing at Morton Way north for the following reasons:-

Morton Way is a natural barrier, once it is breached, the way is open for development up to the A38.

The Morton Way site adds to the lop-sided bulge to the east of Thornbury. People living there will not walk to shop in Thornbury and once in their cars are much more likely to go to the larger centres of Yate, Bradley Stoke or Cribbs Causeway.

Local people and their council have turned down the development, what happened to the much vaunted 'localism' if this is imposed on us by a government inspector?

Thornbury does not need more housing on top of the Park Farm site chosen by the local council and supported by the local people
