Please, please, please rethink the proposed housing due to be constructed at the end of Morton Way in Thornbury.

I believe that once the boundary of Morton Way is breached, the way will be opened for other construction companies to make their case for further building. Thornbury will then no longer be a small market town with a thriving community, but is likely to become a large, faceless conurbation that residents no longer recognise - we have seen this happen in Weston-super-Mare which has lost its former identity - and we will lose forever another chunk of green countryside.
