If I understand things correctly, the government will revoke the *S W Regional Strategy* which forms the basis of the current *Core Strategy*.

As well as that, the new *CLG Household Hrojections* show a large reduction on the previous target.

Both of these issues suggest that the land on Morton Way is not required, and so should be removed from the *Core Strategy*.

If this is so, then the ongoing examination of the Bloor Homes Appeal should result in its rejection as the homes are not needed, the proposal has nothing to do with the health & vitality of Thornbury, and it would be entirely detrimental to the town and its residents.
