

**Mr E Pemberton – Response received on the 1 May 2013**

**Re: Revocation of S W Regional Strategy, and CLG Household Projections 2011 – 2021 (S. Glos Ref: 15 Apr update)**

(1) As the government intends to revoke the S W Regional Strategy I believe land on Morton Way, Thornbury, should be removed from the Core Strategy as its inclusion is (a) contrary to the Government's plan to revoke the Strategy, (b) contrary to the Government's stated determination to protect the countryside and heritage, (c) contrary to the Government's Localism Act, (d) is no longer needed for targets to be achieved, (e) will bring only detriment to the town and its residents.

(2) As the recent release of CLG household projections shows a significant reduction, then the land on Morton Way is again not required.

(3) Although not part of the Core Strategy, on both items 1 & 2 above the Planning Appeal by Bloor Homes should be rejected for reasons a, b, c, d, e.
