DEVELOPMENT OF FILTON AIRFIELD.

Thank you for your letter dated 22 March, 2013. Without knowledge of the various references it is difficult to identify what has been included.

I did however obtain a copy of "Implications and changes to the Core Strategy and supporting documents arising from the proposed redevelopment of Filton Airfield", January 2012.

I noted with interest under Para, i. Development Strategy, Item 8, reference to the provision of open space. That is something I would support and now that it is available I trust it will be used as such.

In my earlier submission I suggested an Arena, a Stadium, and a Skating Rink as useful sources not only of entertainment but also of employment. These would contribute to an "open" atmosphere.

I keep hearing 4,500 houses mentioned. This could mean 9,000 residents, perhaps a similar number of cars and that before shops and schools etc.

What must be avoided is narrow winding roads and continuous blocks of three storey buildings. I would appreciate any information as to current thinking.
