WITH REFERENCE TO THE ENCLOSED DOCUMENTS, ALAN & RUTH MORGAN WISH TO PROTEST TO THE AMOUNT OF NEW DWELLINGS / BUILDINGS IN CONSTRUCTION IN THIS AREA. WE ARE PROTESTING MAINLY ON TRAFFIC GRID LOCKING & CONGESTION GROUNDS.

THE NEARBY RING ROAD IS NOW INADEQUATE DURING PEAK HOURS LOADING. THE STOKE GIFFORD AREA IS CHOKED DURING THE MORNING & EVENING PEAKS.

WE UNDERSTAND THAT THE UNDERTAKING OF A NEW ROAD CONNECTING TO THE PARKWAY NORTH ROUNDABOUT WILL BECOME INADEQUATE DUE TO BRADLEY STOKE PERSONNEL USAGE.

SO WE REQUEST A REVISED LOWER DENSITY OF HOUSING TO TAKE PLACE IN THE EAST OF HARRY STOKE DEVELOPMENT PLAN.
