

## ADOPTION STATEMENT

### **East of Harry Stoke New Neighbourhood Development Framework Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) Jan 2016**

South Gloucestershire Council withdrew the endorsed East of Harry Stoke Development Framework SPD (Jan 2013) and adopted the revised East of Harry Stoke New Neighbourhood Development Framework Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) Jan 2016 at the PT&SE Committee held on 4<sup>th</sup> May 2016. This adoption statement is required by Regulation 14 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2012.

**Title of document** - East of Harry Stoke New Neighbourhood Development Framework Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) Jan 2016

**Subject** - The SPD provides further guidance to support the following policies within the Council's adopted Core Strategy: Policy CS27 East of Harry Stoke New Neighbourhood.

The purpose of the SPD is to support the local authority, developers, housing providers and local communities to deliver the housing allocation, with associated infrastructure and services in a comprehensive manner. The SPD will clarify the details of the planning policy framework and provide guidance on its implementation.

**Area of Document** - The revised SPD applies to the strategic housing allocation for East of Harry Stoke as defined in Policy CS27 of the Core Strategy.
